Description of Presentation: More and more companies are moving to an Agile approach to business. And this is certainly true within IT organizations. Many of these businesses and IT organizations already have Program and/or Project Management Offices established. These PMOs have cost the organizations but most are not willing to just shed their PMOs. The question when moving to a more Agile approach is, do they need to eliminate Project Management Offices? Can traditional PMOs coexist with Scrum Masters, Product Owners, Sprints, and Burn-down Charts. Not to mention Chickens and Pigs?

This presentation will argue that the answer to that question is yes – PMOs can coexist. We will consider three questions:

- 1. What does Agile want?
- 2. What does the PMO want?
- 3. What does the customer want?

Once we answer these three questions, then we can develop a scenario where a Traditional PMO can coexist with Agile/Scrum.

Bio: David Haberman is a Project Management Professional and Certified Scrum Master with experience in developing Project Management Offices (PMOs). David graduated with a BS in Information Science from the University of Pittsburgh and has over 15 years of Project Management, Project Management Office, and Agile Scrum experience in several industries.
