











- Impacts all PMI certifications



CCR Program Changes

Summary of Changes

- Number of recertification PDUs is not changing
- · What's changing:
 - Education PDUs minimum jumps from 15 to 35 PDUs, with 8 needed in each of the three talent triangle areas



Giving Back to the Profession - maximum number of PDUs that can be earned has decreased from 45 to 25, and number of PDUs earned for Working as a Professional has decreased from 15 to 8

The PMI Talent Triangle

- Technical Project Management: Knowledge, skills and behaviors related to specific practice domains of project, program and portfolio management (the technical aspects of performing your job)
- Leadership: Knowledge, skills and behaviors specific to motivating and guiding others - leadership-oriented skills that help an organization achieve its business goals
- Strategic and Business Management:
 Knowledge of and expertise in the industry or organization that enhances performance and better delivers business outcomes

Education Category Changes

 60% of PDUs (minimum of 35) are now required in the education category (was 15 PDUs)

 PDUs must be earned in Technical Project Management, Leadership, and Strategic and **Business Management**

Technical Skill Class Examples

- 1. 8-hour class on project scope and quality management
- 2. 12-hour course on portfolio management with 3 hours spent on the risk register
- 3. 16-hour PM knowledge areas course; 2 hours on requirements, 1 hour on risk, 2 hours on scheduling and 1 hour on agile

Multiple A Leg Examples

- 14-hour class on project management with 4 hours on business case development, 2 hours on leadership and 3 hours on project negotiations (total of 5 hours on leadership topics)
- 5. 7-hour course on project communications
- 3-hour virtual course on enterprise analysis (process flow diagrams, feasibility studies, business case analysis)

Giving Back Category Changes


- Activities remain the same: Volunteering, Creating Knowledge and Working as a **Professional**
- The maximum number of total PDUs that can be earned in this category has decreased from 45 to 25
- The total number of PDUs to be earned in Working as a Professional has decreased from 15 to 8


