

# Apply for PMI Pittsburgh Chapter Milestone Scholarship

To recognize PMI Pittsburgh Chapter's 35 year anniversary milestones, and to honor our chapter's commitment to the project management profession, PMI Educational Foundation (PMIEF) has setup a PMI Pittsburgh Chapter Milestone Scholarship for the amount of \$3,000.

PMIEF is a non-profit, non-political, public charitable organization that advances project management knowledge as well as the application of project management concepts and theory. Founded by PMI in 1990, PMIEF brings the benefits and power of project management to local communities and to the farthest reaches of the world for social good through its development and administration of scholarships, grants, programs and educational resources.

PMI Pittsburgh Chapter is eligible to receive US \$3,000 to award professional development scholarships to chapter members who demonstrate an outstanding commitment to project management and wish to enhance their professional capabilities through relevant coursework.

**The scholarship application period will commence May 1 and conclude July 31, 2015 and will be online.**

Details about the scholarship:

- Each chapter's total scholarship funds will be expended until exhausted
- Each chapter's total scholarship funds will be awarded either whole or in part to either one or more individuals.
- PMI Global will use an external panel of volunteer judges (who are project managers) will review applications to determine scholarship recipients; Pittsburgh chapter do not need to anything.
- Scholarship recipients will receive reimbursement for their course once they provide proof of course registration and receipt of payment. They may submit this information via either mail/courier or e-mail.
- Both classroom and online courses are eligible for reimbursement.
- Scholarship cannot be used as college tuition.
- Reimbursements will only be issued for the cost of the course. Neither textbook nor examination fees will be reimbursed.
- Notification to awardees will be sent via email to each applicant in September.
- Candidates who have not received the award will also be notified via email.
- Course taken should be between August 1 and December 31 2015. I recommend use the scholarship for the Professional Development Day in November, approximately \$400.
